LND, Inc – Commitment to the Environment

Environment Policy Statement

LND, Incorporated is committed to protect the health and safety of our employees, customers and the environment. Our safety office continually interfaces with our suppliers to ensure that the products that we are provided are environmentally compliant with current global regulations. Our goal is to consistently respond to the changing requirements of our customers, including their environmental issues. At times individual countries and industries implement specific environmental product standards. At LND, Inc. we continuously monitor and respond to these directives.

LND, Inc. has reviewed the European Union's Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS2) Directive 2011/65/EU and the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive 2012/19/EU. These directives specify that certain applications are *exempted* from compliance with regards to the use of restricted substances (as listed in Annex II of 2011/65/EU) in electric and electronic equipment, as well as the recovery and disposal of equipment containing those restricted substances.

LND, Inc. claims an exempt status from these directives for the following reasons:

- LND, Inc. routinely supplies replacement detector tubes to customers using equipment placed on the market prior to 1 July 2006;
- We supply detector tubes to the medical community and medical equipment manufacturers for monitoring the use of radioactive isotopes;
- We supply detector tubes to military organizations (U.S. and NATO) and to customers involved with the ever growing national security technology field;
- These detector tubes do not have a direct function when not incorporated into another installation;
- Our detector tubes cannot fulfill their main function without being connected to a base unit containing a power source;
- Lead contained in glass frit binder used for assembly is exempt;
- Lead contained in electronic ceramic parts is exempt.
